First Day of School & Kindergarten Gradual Entry

Tuesday, Sept. 2nd is our first day of school for students in Grades 1-7 starting at 8:45 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

The **Kindergarten** gradual entry schedule which begins on Sept. 2^{nd} to 12^{th} was sent out via email to parents in June. Please refer to your schedule for the exact times your child will be expected in class.

Regular attendance and prompt arrival at school is important if your child is to gain full benefit from the school program. Please ensure your child arrives on time each day. If your child is going to be late or absent for any reason, please use the Report Absentee link on the school website or email the school office at office@stemunds.ca. If we do not receive a call, email or notification and your child is not at school, we will call parents to ensure their safe arrival.

School Lunches & Snacks

Please ensure your child brings a **healthy snack and lunch** each day, along with a **refillable**, **labeled water bottle**. To reduce waste and support our commitment to environmental stewardship, all **leftover food will be sent home** for composting. We encourage families to pack lunches in **reusable**, **labeled plastic containers** (no glass) to help minimize landfill waste.

Hot Lunch Program - begins **Monday, September 15**. Orders must be placed by **Tuesday, September 9** via our online system (see the <u>Hot Lunch Link</u> on our school website). We follow the **BC School Food Guidelines**, which promote whole foods, plant-based nutrition, and reduced processed and sugary items. Our menu is updated regularly to reflect these healthy standards. If you have any questions, please contact the school office. Thank you for supporting our lunch program!

Medical Alerts & Allergies

A safe and healthy school is a shared responsibility between students, parents, and staff. Some of our students have severe nut allergies, and even trace amounts of peanuts or tree nuts can pose a serious risk. To support a **nut-aware environment**, we ask all families to avoid sending snacks or lunches that contain nuts or nut oils. Thank you for your cooperation.

Families of students with EpiPens must provide an **updated EpiPen and emergency action plan** signed by a doctor each year, even if there are no changes. Please submit these to the school office.

Health and Safety Updates

A reminder that the following Health & Safety Protocols continue to be in place for all staff & students:

- Daily Health Check Stay home if sick
- Mask wearing is a personal choice
- Continued emphasis on diligent hand & respiratory hygiene
- Frequently touched surfaces to be cleaned daily
- Vaccines "It is important to get all recommended vaccine doses to get the most effective protection against serious cases of COVID-19." Please note, the school does not collect or keep any COVID vaccination records.

School Bags

We kindly ask that students avoid bringing rolling bags to school. While convenient, these bags create a tripping hazard in our cubby areas and hallways. For safety and ease of storage, traditional backpacks are strongly preferred. Thank you for your cooperation in helping us keep our school environment safe for all students.

Student Drop Off / Pick Up Procedure

The "safety first" procedure for dropping off and picking up of students is as follows:

- The posted speed limit is 30 km/hr during school hours (8:00 am 5:00 pm)
- The drop off area on Mahon Avenue in front of the school is for drop-off only NO PARKING. The Fire Zone is also a NO STOPPING area. If you need to assist your child in getting out of the car, you must park on another block and walk your child to the gate.
- If you need to park your car, please be conscientious of our neighbours. You may park along the tennis court area on 6th or along the school on 5th Street.
